Elementary General Music

Lesson Plan Formats

Format 1

Music Concept	The goal(s) or understanding(s) that will result from the lesson.
Music	The musical selection or selections upon which the lesson is based.
Objectives(s)	Statements specifying what students will be able to do as a result of the lesson and how they will demonstrate their learning.
Materials	Recordings, books, transparencies, instruments, worksheets - whatever is needed for the lesson to be successful.
The Lesson	Instruction will begin here.
Focus	A focus statement or action to capture the attention of the students that relates to the lesson.
Key Terms	Musical terms that will be used in the lesson.
Step 1, 2, 3, etc.	Each segment of the lesson is numbered, providing a logical sequence for the teaching and development of music concepts and skills.
Adaptations	A list of adaptations for special learners and for alternate approaches to music teaching (Orff, Kodály, Dalcroze, Gordon, cooperative learning) is helpful.
Indicator of Success	This is the behavior that will identify how and when the students demonstrate understanding of the lesson concept, usually an informal observable behavior by the teacher.
Summary	The summary can be accomplished best by having the students summarize rather than having the teacher summarize. This is the end of the class instruction.
Assessment	Informal or formal evaluation may be used as well as opportunities for extended learning or application of the new concept to different situations or music.



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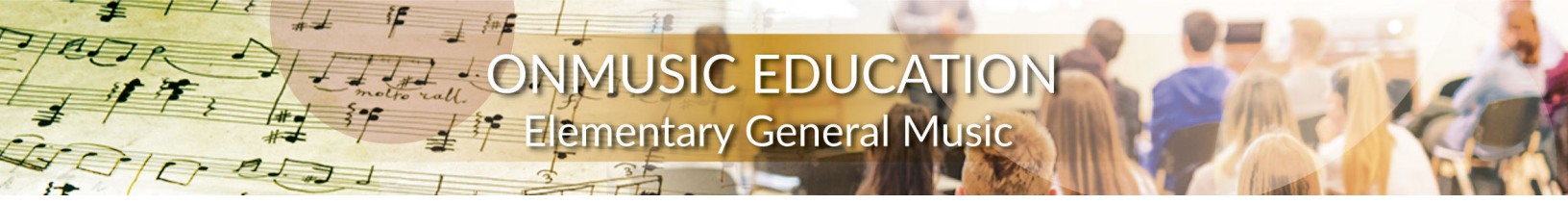
